INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHT CELL

The development of science and technology, and spread of information across nations, have made inventions and creations more common place. While this has opened up immense amounts of possibilities in terms of opportunities available to individuals and organizations, it has also increased the ways in which one can be violated. Various examples of such situations in the past, mandate that the presence of a legal security cover is necessary to protect the individual's intellectual property against abuse or exploitation. Thus, the Intellectual Property rights became a part of the legal frameworks around the globe. Rights protected under exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his invention/ creation for a given period of time.

Rights protected under IPR be fully realized only when individuals are fully aware of what they entail. Rights protected under IPR are Patents, Copyrights, Trademarks, Industrial designs, Protection of Integrated Circuits layout design, Geographical indications of goods, Biological diversity, Plant varieties and farmer's rights and undisclosed information (Trade secrets). In order to raise such an awareness among the faculty and students, Siena College of Professional Studies established an IPR Cell on 15 January 2020. This cell was headed by Mrs Roopa Ruby Mathew and 4 other committee members. As part of the same initiative, the P G Department of Commerce offered a certificate course titled Intellectual Property Rights to the students of B.Com Travel and Tourism during the academic year 2021-2022. And the MG University offered IPR as a course to the 6th semester BBA. On completion of the course, students should be able to know the concepts of patent and trademark protection.

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The IPR Cell aims to provide awareness through webinars, seminars and expert talks and provide a real-world understanding of these legalities. The cell was constituted to promote the creation of intellectual property from amongst the faculties and students. Thus, this initiative helps to bridge any gap that may currently exist, wipe out the myths and hearsays and thereby make every individual fully aware of what they and their intellectual property are entitled to, so that an optimal conducive environment for everyone can be created.

- To organize meetings with the experts for identifying patentable inventions.
- To create conductive ambience for the development of Intellectual Property (IP).
